

MBA (Regular) Admission Test Question Pattern

To be enrolled on the MBA program, the eligible candidates must appear in the competitive examination, consisting of two phases: written test and viva-voce. To qualify for the admission test, a candidate must get at least 40% marks individually in written exam and Viva-Voce.

Phase 1: Written Test

General Guidelines

- The written test consists of two sections: Section **I** contains a topic for thematic writing, while Section **II** comprises Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ)
- In section **I**, the applicants may require developing a descriptive or argumentative essay on a contemporary topic.
- The MCQ questions are generally designed to test candidates' knowledge on Finance, Accounting, Marketing, Management, Economics, and Mathematical aptitude.
- Any type of calculator is not allowed during the test
- The duration of the exam is one hour

Phase 2: Viva-Voce

Only the short-listed applicants will be called to appear in the viva-voce. There will be 10 marks for this segment. Applicants must obtain at least 40% marks to qualify.
